OF INTEREST TO EVERYONE.

1. The Committee reserve the right to alter the order of Events.
2. Competitors will be given due warning before each race and they must at once proceed to their respective marks. No competitor will be waited for, and anyone not in time for the heat in which his name appears will not be allowed to run in any other.
3. Every competitor will wear a card bearing the number prefixed to his name on the programme, and same should be pinned through centre of number to back of jersey. This card will be supplied to him by one of the Stewards.
4. No attendant shall accompany any competitor on the scratch or in the race.
5. Betting strictly prohibited, and any person so offending will be prosecuted.
6. The Handicaps contained in this programme are made up to and including Monday, 3rd August, 1931.
7. Travelling information may be obtained from the responsible Official in competitors' dressing room.
8. None but Officials, Members of the Press, and Competitors for the time being will be allowed within the Enclosure. (This is fact, not fiction).
9. At the conclusion of each event the result will be notified on the Telegraph Board.
10. In the High Jump each Competitor shall be allowed three jumps at each height. Crossing the scratch without displacing the bar shall not count as one jump. All measurements shall be made from the ground to the centre of the bar.
11. In the event of a difference of opinion between the Judges, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
12. The General Committee of the Association shall have a final decision in all cases not provided in the above rules.
