### MAUCHLINE SCOUT GROUP

HE Mauchline Scout Group was formed in 1928 under the administration of Lt.-Col. A. C. Adair, O.B.E., who was the District Commissioner. It continued to function under a succession of capable and enthusiastic officers until 1939 when the needs of the Country denuded the Group of its officers. The Group thus went into abeyance until December, 1949, when Group Scoutmaster James Fleming again got the Mauchline Group functioning. So far, the Group consists of Scouts and Wolf Cubs only, but it is hoped that a Rover Crew may be formed in the near future.

Since its earliest formation, the Scouts and Cubs have used various premises throughout the Village for their meeting nights and that accommodation was much appreciated and used to excellent purpose, but, obviously, the use of such accommodation is limited and hinders the proper functioning of the Group. Naturally, the ideal accommodation would be a suitable and well-equipped Headquarters under the Group's own control in which camping and other equipment could be stored and found accessible as required.

In the past, the Group had the advantage of a very sympathetic and energetic Committee under the chairmanship of Mr. Stuart M. Fraser, and a Building Fund for the provision of Group Headquarters was started by this Committee.

By the year 1939, the provision of Group Headquarters was on the point of realisation. The Building Fund had a little over  $\pounds 200$  in hand and had negotiated for a suitable site in which to build the premises. Unfortunately, war was declared before this could be accomplished, and, as stated earlier, the Country's needs came first. As time went on, the financial affairs of the Group were safeguarded by some faithful friends and finally came into the safekeeping of Mr. T. H. M. Donaldson.

Early this year the present Group Committee, under the chairmanship of Mr. S. G. Paterson, set to work in an effort to continue the good work already started by the pre-war Group Committee, and were in the happy position of receiving from Mr. Donaldson a credit banking account for £225 in the name of Mauchline Scout Group Building Fund.

Owing to the increased cost of material, it is now estimated that the cost of providing a Group Headquarters is in the region of from £800 to £1000 as compared with the pre-war estimate of £400.

It is hoped that the sum realised from the Garden Fête, with the help of some good friends of the Group, will be sufficient to encourage the Committee in their efforts and bring considerably nearer the time when Mauchline Scout Group will own their own Headquarters.
